# Website Design Live Challenge

#### Scenario:

On the day of the tournament, your team will be given information including pictures and other elements about a business. You will construct a website using information given to you. Your team will use the website platform of your choice in your presentation to the judges.

### **Challenge:**

- Create a one-page website (or any web-based software) to represent and analyze the information in a clear and visually appealing way.
- Present your information to the judges.

#### Time:

Your team will have:

- 45 minutes to create a website, analyze the information and plan a presentation.
- 5 minutes to present your findings to the judges.
